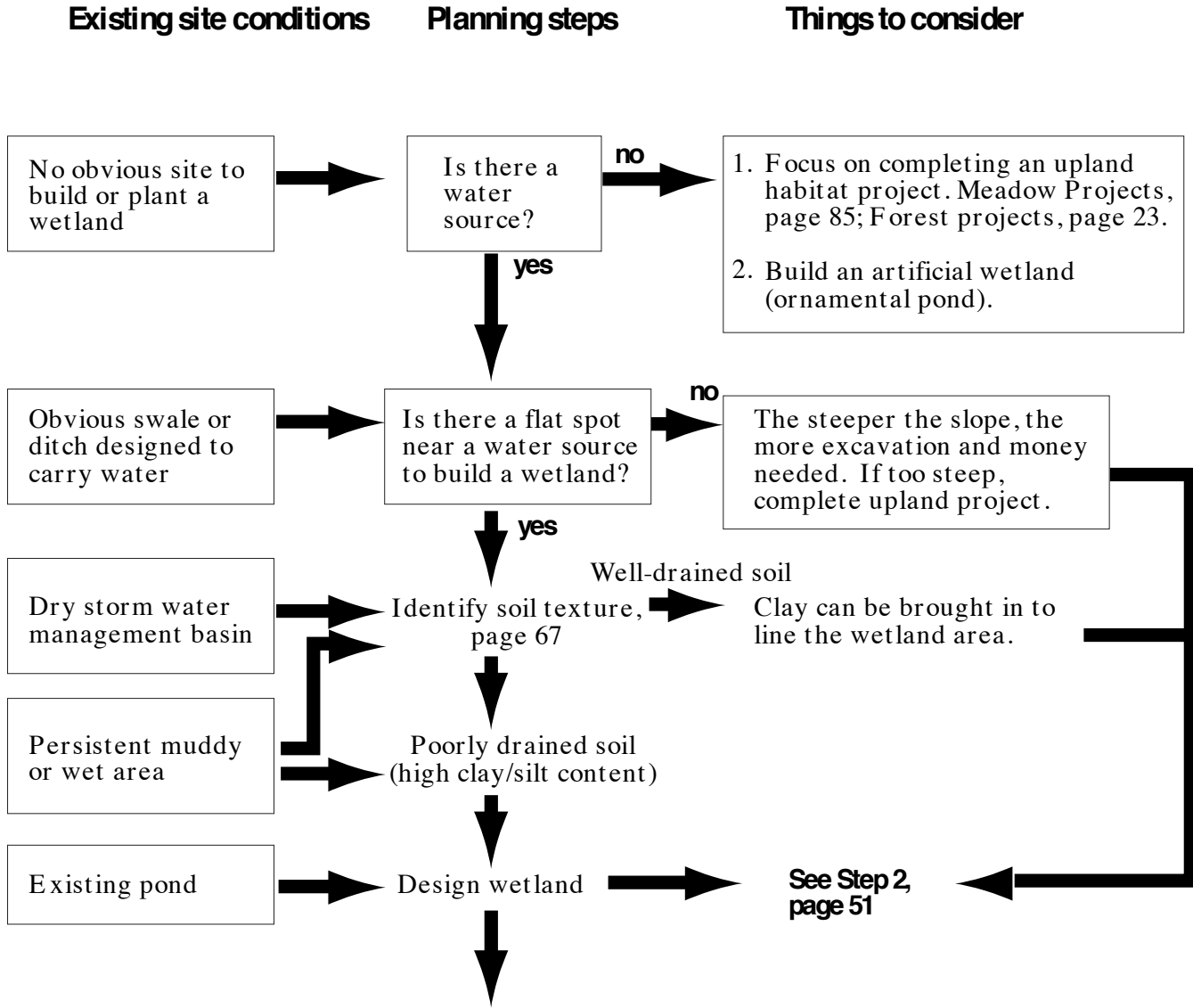


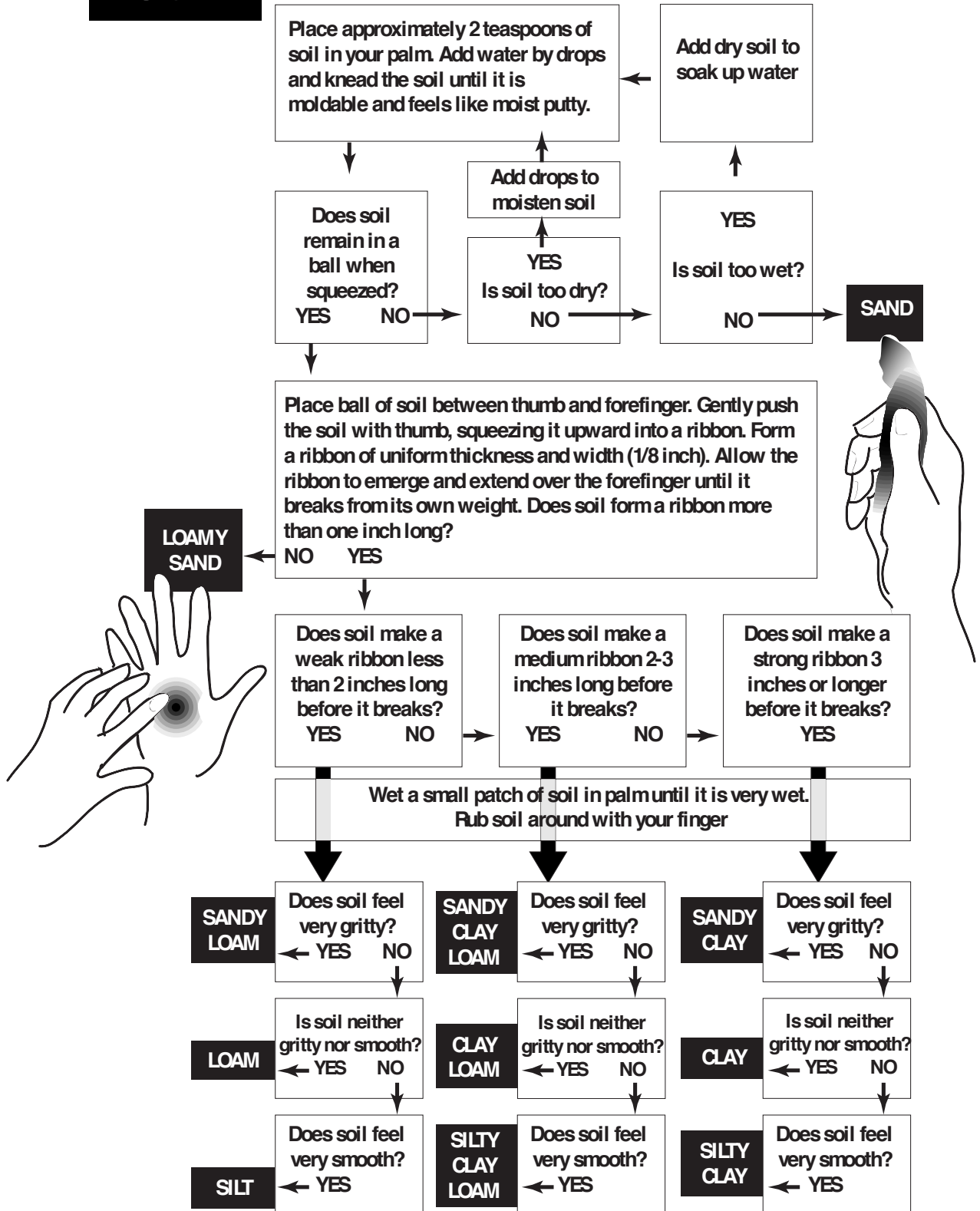
Wetland Planning Chart
